

LOCATION

The sweeping beauty and pristine outdoor environment of the Sunshine Coast has caught the attention of international film makers. This past week, the final episode of the hugely popular 36 part Survivor-Return of the Outcasts series was aired on on M-Net's Channel 101. The series was shot on locations along the Fish River Beach, Kap River and Fort d'Acre.

No sooner was the final episode of Survivor filmed, before BBC Channel 4 moved in to film a new British reality TV show. The series is set to be screened in the U.K. and other European destinations and will feature spectacular scenery filmed on the Sunshine Coast. 
